

PERFORMER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Coast Acoustics was established in 2005 to support live music on the Gold Coast. It is a not for profit community organisation run by volunteers. All proceeds go towards paying for club activities.

Performers must complete a performer application, which is available on the club website.

Performers are encouraged to show their support for live music by becoming a member of Coast Acoustics. Members may be given preference for paid gigs.

If a suitable gig becomes available, the person nominated on the application form will be sent a letter of offer showing the details. Acceptance must be confirmed within 2 weeks.

If any changes are proposed, Coast Acoustics must be notified. Coast Acoustics may amend the offer accordingly.

Coast Acoustics gigs may be subject to change. If the gig is cancelled or changed, Coast Acoustics will advise ASAP but is under no obligation to pay any compensation to the performer.

All band members must have appropriate public liability insurance.

Performers accept all responsibility for their own tax obligations, superannuation and worker's compensation.

The letter of offer includes all expenses. There are no additional funds for travel or accommodations.

Unless otherwise arranged, Coast Acoustics does not organise travel and accommodation.

Coast Acoustics provides the PA. Performers provide their own instruments and anything else they need for their performance.

Performers are responsible for anything they bring to Coast Acoustics. Coast Acoustics is not responsible for any loss or damage.

Performers must be on site one hour before the gig or the program may be rescheduled. If there is likely to be a delay, the nominated Coast Acoustics contact must be advised ASAP.

Please respect our volunteers. Coast Acoustics reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone who is rude to volunteers, disruptive to our patrons or demonstrates unwelcome behaviour.

Performers and their equipment must comply with government health and safety requirements.

The music should be played predominantly on acoustic instruments. An acoustic instrument is an instrument that does not require amplification.

Except for bass guitars, solid body electric guitars are not to be used without prior approval.

Percussion instruments, brushes and small drum kits are generally acceptable but must not dominate the stage. Sticks and full drum kits are generally too loud for Coast Acoustics gigs. Prior approval is required.

Any acoustic music style is acceptable. Original music is encouraged.

Performers are required to actively promote Coast Acoustics gigs through websites and social media. Preference will often be given to performers who demonstrate that they will bring a crowd.

Performers may sell CDs and other merchandise at Coast Acoustics.

Coast Acoustics is located in a public park and is subject to Council laws.
